On Wednesday, January 16, 2019, U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer Jonathan R. Farmer died in a suicide bomb attack in Manbij, Syria. Chief Warrant Officer Jonathan R. Farmer, of Palm Beach County, was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 5th Special Forces Group out of Fort Campbell, Kentucky. As a mark of respect for Chief Warrant Officer Jonathan R. Farmer, I hereby direct the flags of the United States and the State of Florida to be flown at half-staff at the Palm Beach County Courthouse in West Palm Beach, Florida, the City Hall in Boynton Beach, Florida, and at the State Capitol in Tallahassee, Florida, from sunrise to sunset on Tuesday, April 9, 2019.
