EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-16

(Removing Confidentiality of Executive Order 21-257)

WHEREAS, by Confidential Executive Order 21-257, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, was assigned to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit to discharge the duties of the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, in all matters relating to a criminal investigation regarding alleged improprieties by City of Miami officials and/or employees for charter violations, extortion, and other forms of corruption within the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the office of the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit has requested that Executive Order 21-257 no longer remain confidential; and

WHEREAS, under section 27.151, Florida Statutes, the Governor may make public a previously confidential executive order filed pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 21-257, which assigned the State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida relating to a criminal investigation regarding alleged improprieties by City of Miami officials and/or

employees for charter violations, extortion, and other forms of corruption within the City of Miami, is no longer confidential.
