

## Department of Education

### 1. **School Accountability System (TBD)**

Provides stability and clarity to Florida's students, parents, and teachers during the transition to new state assessments pursuant to the Florida Plan for Education Accountability.

### 2. **Student Data Security Act (SB 188- Sen. Hukill / HB 195- Rep. Raburn)**

- a. Sets policies and establishes safeguards for the collection, maintenance and use of student data by DOE.
- b. Outlines activities DOE is not allowed to do, including:
  - i. Collect certain types of non-educational records;
  - ii. Disclose personally identifiable information, without parental consent, for commercial use; and
  - iii. Transfer personally identifiable student records to the federal government except as needed for audits of federal programs.

### 3. **\$10.6 billion in state funds for the FEFP, including**

- a. \$40 million for digital learning
- b. \$480 million for teacher salaries

### 4. **\$13.4 million for Principal and Teacher Professional Development**

### 5. **\$243.8 million for Fixed Capital Outlay, including**

- a. \$171.7 million in Maintenance for Public Schools, Charter Schools and the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind
- b. \$72.1 million for Special Facility Construction Critical Needs in Rural Districts
