WHY

One way to combat human trafficking is to raise public awareness. This event would start a statewide conversation among community members, students, advocates and other professionals about the status of human trafficking in our state. This event could also be used to honor Floridians working to combat human trafficking in our state.

For example, awards could be created to recognize an:

- Advocate;
- Prosecutor;
- Law Enforcement Official;
- Community Coalition/Task Force; and,
- Student, via an essay contest.

HOW

- **Travel.** The Florida State University Center for the Advancement of Human Rights is willing to fund speaker costs for certain speakers.
- **Web.** The Governor's Office of Adoption and Child Protection has the capability to create an event Website. The internet would also be used as the primary vehicle for advertising the event, etc. so that printing costs, etc. could be reduced.
- **Staff.** The Florida Department of Juvenile Justice is able to dedicate a part-time OPS staffer to manage event details, handle RSVP's and provide general coordinating support.
- **IT.** The Florida State University Center for the Advancement of Human Rights can absorb any costs associated with the space and IT assistance.
- **Parking.** Participants would have to incur parking costs on their own.
