Education is a top priority for Mayor Brown's administration. By building a stronger education system, we can empower young people to become self-sufficient decision-makers who will thrive amid the challenges of the 21st Century global economy.

Learn2Earn is a summer program designed for high school students who are on summer break awaiting their sophomore or junior years. Learn2Earn targets low-to-moderate income students with caregivers that have not attended college. Students entering senior year may be granted an exception to enroll. Learn2Earn is open to all students in public and private schools as well as home-schooled students. There is no cost to students, and the student to mentor ratio is 10 to 1.

Applicant Criteria

1. Student must be a **rising high school sophomore or junior** (exceptions may be made for a rising high school senior on a case-by-case basis).
2. Student must have a **GPA of 2.5 or higher**.
3. Student must have **an acceptable disciplinary record, both in and out of school**.
4. Preference will be given to students whose **primary caregivers have not attended college**.
5. Preference will be given to students who are **Title 1 (on free or reduced lunches)**.
6. Nominations are **open to all students** in public and private schools as well as home-schooled students.
