EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11- 133

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 10-135 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Clement Plummer a/k/a Bernard Williams; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not been completed as the defendant was on alias capias status and has now been located and a hearing is set for August 26, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to Section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 10-135 is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including June 25, 2012.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before May 25, 2012, if additional time is required.
