EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-256

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11-250 assigned the Honorable MICHAEL MCAULIFFE, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit to discharge the duties of the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ regarding a notice to appear for Yasser Kader; and

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit had accepted this assignment and it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Order 11-250;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby promulgate the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-250 is hereby dissolved.
