OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-68

(Special Election – House District 110)

WHEREAS, Section 100.101(2), Florida Statutes, provides that a vacancy in the office of state House of Representatives shall be filled by special election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 114.01(1)(d), Florida Statutes, a vacancy now exists in the state House of Representatives due to the resignation of Representative Esteban L. Bovo, House District 110; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 100.141(1), Florida Statutes, the Governor is obligated, after consulting with the Secretary of State, to issue an order declaring the date the special election shall be held;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1.

A special election shall be held in House District 110 to fill the vacancy in the state House of Representatives.

Section 2.

A special primary election shall be held on May 24, 2011.

Section 3.

A special general election shall be held on June 28, 2011, to select the state Representative for House District 110.
