OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-248 (Amending Executive Order 13-243)

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2013, Executive Order 13-243 was issued assigning the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Circuit, to the First Judicial Circuit to handle charges relating to Jonathan David Ward; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 13-243 incorrectly referenced Jerold Lee Mason, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS advised the Governor that Jonathan David Ward is related to an employee of the state attorney's office; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 13-243 is amended to remove reference to Jerold Lee Mason, Jr. and to reflect that because Jonathan David Ward is related to an employee of the state attorney's office, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, has requested the assignment of another state attorney to handle the case and the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit regarding charges pending against Jonathan David Ward.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-243 is ratified and reaffirmed.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-243

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RICK SCOTT that Jonathan David Ward has been arrested, in Santa Rosa County, for sexual battery (victim over 12 years of age); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS has also advised the Governor that Jerold lee Mason, Jr. is related by marriage to an employee of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, to avoid a conflict of interest or any appearance of impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney with respect to the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable GLENN HESS discharge the duties of the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, pursuant to Section 27.14, Florida Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant

to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1.

The Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, as they relate to the investigation, prosecution and all matters related to Jerold Lee Mason, Jr.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3.

All residents of the First Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4.

The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including September 4, 2014.

Section 5.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before August 4, 2014,
if additional time is required.
