OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-285 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-267)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-267, to the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against James Rawe for grand theft (\$300 - \$5,000); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that allegations have been made against James Rawe for dealing in stolen property; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge of dealing in stolen property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 13-267 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of dealing in stolen property.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-267 is ratified and reaffirmed.
