OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-339

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 12-269, amended by Executive Order 13-79, to the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Matthew Stephen Peterson and Savino Musella; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not been completed as the case regarding Savino Musella is pending and Matthew Stephen Peterson was placed in a pretrial diversion program which will continue to supervised for the next 12 months; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-269, amended by Executive Order 13-79, is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including December 14, 2014.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before November 14, 2014, if additional time is required.
