EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-347
(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, Frances Rosario, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 1, 2013, Frances Rosario was convicted in the circuit court of the Ninth Judicial Circuit in and for Orange County in case number 2012CF006710 of Grand Theft (\$100,000 or more), a first-degree felony offense pursuant to Section 812.014(2)(a)1., Florida Statutes, and Scheme to Defraud (\$50,000 or more), a first-degree felony offense pursuant to Section 817.034(4)(a)1.; and

WHEREAS, a public official convicted of a felony offense may be removed from office by executive order of the Governor, pursuant to Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Frances Rosario be immediately removed from the public office, which she now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Frances Rosario is hereby removed from the public office of Notary

Public.
