OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-363 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-323)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-323, to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to prosecute charges pending against Jamal Bethel for armed robbery with a firearm or deadly and in a separate case with attempted armed robbery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are additional subsequent charges files against Jamal Bethel including carrying a concealed weapon; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

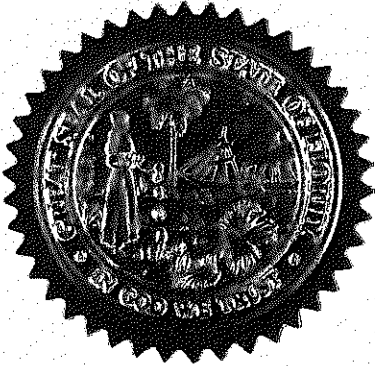
Section 1.

Executive Order 13-323 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of carrying a concealed firearm.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-323 is ratified and reaffirmed.
