EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 14-244

WHEREAS, Ray Russell Domer, a member of the Okeechobee County Board of Commissioners, has passed away; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent officer; and

WHEREAS, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to a vacancy in office,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Ray Russell Domer, a vacancy currently exists on the Okeechobee County Board of Commissioners, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
