OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-263 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-230)

WHEREAS, the Honorable CATHERINE VOGEL, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-230 to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Dachel Gonzalez for grand theft third degree; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that an allegation of violation of probation has been made against Dachel Gonzalez as a result of the grand theft charge; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable CATHERINE VOGEL, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 15-230 is hereby amended to include the additional allegation of violation of probation filed against Dachel Gonzalez.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-230 is ratified and reaffirmed.
