## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-140 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-109)

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-109 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Martin Curtis Courtney for no motorcycle authorization on driver's license and petit theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Martin Curtis Courtney has additionally been charged with child neglect, aggravated child abuse-causing great bodily harm, and aggravated battery with a deadly weapon (case number 4616CF001164A). In another case, (4616MM001680A), he has been charged with resisting an officer without violence and possession of drug paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 16-109 is hereby amended to include the additional charges of child neglect, aggravated child abuse-causing great bodily harm, aggravated battery with a deadly weapon, resisting an officer without violence, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-109 is ratified and reaffirmed.
