OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-325 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 17-117)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 17-117 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case pending against Aimee Nichole Griffin for possession of a controlled substance without a prescription; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Aimee Nichole Griffin has been arrested for dealing in stolen property by trafficking, grand theft (\$300 or more but less than \$5,000), and use of fraudulently obtained receipt; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges and allegations in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 17-117 is hereby amended to include the charges of dealing in stolen property by trafficking, grand theft (\$300 or more but less than \$5,000), and use of fraudulently obtained receipt.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-117 is ratified and reaffirmed.
