

# STATE OF FLORIDA

## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-217 (State Attorney Executive Assignment)

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Allison Marie Crouse was arrested for driving under the influence with property damage or personal injury; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN has also advised the Governor that Allison Marie Crouse is an employee of the state attorney's office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, to avoid a conflict of interest or any appearance of impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney with respect to the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT discharge the duties of the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS**, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1. The Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties

of the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as they relate to the investigation, prosecution, and all matters related to Allison Marie Crouse.

Section 2. The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3. All residents of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4. The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including September 24, 2022.

Section 5. The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before August 24, 2022, if additional time is required.
