OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21-52 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-272)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 20-272 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case involving Jeremiah Hunt who was charged, in three separate case,s with possession of Eutylone, corruption by threat, two counts of petit theft and failure to leave property upon order; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Jeremiah Hunt has recently been arrested for retail theft \$300 or more, subsequent offense, second degree felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 20-272 is hereby amended to include the charge of retail theft \$300 or more, subsequent offense, second degree felony.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 20-272 is ratified and reaffirmed.
