Governor Scott has declared a vacancy on the Ninth Judicial Circuit Court, brought about by the resignation of Judge Anthony H. Johnson. Accordingly, the Ninth Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission is now accepting applications for this vacancy.

Qualification of Applicants:

Applicants must have been a member of The Florida Bar for the preceding five years and must be a registered voter. The person appointed must be a resident of either Orange or Osceola County at the time that he/she assumes office.
