The 19th Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission announces that the deadline for submitting applications to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of **County Judge Philip Yacucci, Jr.** has been reopened. **The new application deadline is May 3, 2019 at 3:00 p.m.**

Applicant interviews are moved to **Tuesday, May 14, 2019**. The interviews will be conducted at 201 South Indian River Drive, Fort Pierce, Florida, St. Lucie County Clerk's Office, 5th floor conference room of the Chief Administrative Officer, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

The Commission's deadline for completing interviews and providing names to Governor DeSantis is **May 20, 2019**.

The following procedures apply to new applicants only, and not to applicants who have already submitted completed applications for this vacancy:

1. Applications received after the May 3, 2019 deadline will not be considered. All applicants must be, and have been, members of The Florida Bar for the preceding five (5) years, electors of the State of Florida, and residents of St. Lucie County before taking office.

2. All persons interested in applying must deliver a completed application, saved in PDF format, on a flash drive or USB thumb drive, to each member of the JNC at the address listed with the Florida Bar. There shall be one flash drive per Commissioner, eight (8) flash drives total. Each flash drive shall list the applicant's name clearly on the exterior of the flash drive. Each PDF must be a single file. No other attachments or files are to be included on the flash drives. Please be sure to include the financial disclosure information requested in the application, inclusive of a completed Form 6 (Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interest). Please include a scan of a recent photograph on the cover of your digital application.

3. One hard copy of the completed application, along with a hard copy of the redacted application excluding all exempt information under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or other applicable public records law, shall also be delivered to the Chair only (including the financial disclosure information requested in the application).

4. The Judicial Applications are available online at The Florida Bar website www.flabar.org.

5. All letters of recommendation in your possession that you wish the Commission to consider shall be included as attachments to application. Any additional information which you feel may be helpful to the Commission in assessing your qualifications shall be included as attachments to application.

After the deadline for submitting applications, the Commission will determine which applicants will be interviewed. If you are selected to be interviewed, you will be contacted to confirm the date, time and location of your interview.

All proceedings of the Commission are open to the public, except for deliberations. Members of the bench, bar and the public are encouraged to contact the Commission about applicants.
