Applications delivered after the deadline **WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED**. All applicants must have been members of the Florida Bar for at least five (5) years, electors of the State of Florida, and be resident of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit prior to taking office.

2. The Judicial Application (which can be obtained from the Florida Bar website www.flabar.org) must include:

- An original and nine (9) copies of the application, with the original clearly marked;
- A recent photograph must be attached to the original and each copy;
- All letters of recommendation in your possession that you wish the Commissioner to consider. However, these letters may also be sent as supplements to each member of the Commission, after the application is submitted;
- The financial disclosure information requested in the application, inclusive of a completed Form 6 (Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interest);

- Any additional information which you feel may be helpful to the Commission in assessing your qualifications.

3. Please follow all requests and instructions in this notice as failing to do so could result in your application not being considered.

4. It is suggested that you submit your application as soon as it is prepared and well before the deadline.

5. After the deadline for submitting applications, the Commission will determine which applicants to interview. If you are to be interviewed, you will be contacted to confirm date, time and location.

6. The interviews will be conducted on Monday, May 2, 2016 at a location and time to be determined.

7. As you know, all proceedings of the Commission are open to the public except for deliberations. Accordingly, you should not expect your application and/or information to be kept confidential.

8. If an applicant is nominated, all materials attached to the original application will be submitted to the Governor and the Governor's office may ask for additional copies of same.
